


FAILTE IN SCOTLAND

8 DAYS / 7 NIGHTS

This tour will show you a first vision of Scotland





DAY 1 : GLASGOW	DAY 2: LOCH LOMOND – GLEN COE	DAY 3: ISLE OF SKYE – LOCH NESS	DAY 4 : HIGHLAND
Arrival at Glasgow Airport. Your guide and driver will wait for you after immigration controls. Transfert to your hotel. Early check in. Rest of morning at leisure. At 2,00pm your guide will meet you for guided panoramic tour of the city. Highlights include red sandstone Victorian buildings, delightful parks, Glasgow Cathedral and the River Clyde, once important for shipbuilding. Visit the extensive and varied art collections in Kelvingrove Art Gallery and Museum In the evening, enjoy a welcome drink with your group before dinner.	Sottish breakfast at hotel. Depart Glasgow for the scenery of the loch Lomond. Embark on a short cruise to appreciate the beauty of this famous loch and admire panoramic views. Next stop is Inveraray for lunch followed by a guided tour of Inveraray Castle, featured in "Downton Abbey". Now en route to deep Scotland. Journey across Rannoch Moor and through Glencoe, often considered one of Scotland's most spectacular and beautiful places. Dinner at hotel	Sottish breakfast at hotel. This morning we take the scenic "Road to the Isles", Stop for photos at the Glenfinnan Monument. Ferry to the Isle of Skye to visit Armadale Castle, a romantic ruin surrounded by magnificent gardens. After lunch, we are back on the mainland, travel along the shores of Loch Ness. A few more photos stops. Dinner at hotel.	Sottish breakfast at hotel. First stop this morning is the Culloden Battlefield Visitor Centre where the British government forces defeated the army of Prince Charles Edward Stuart, popularly known as Bonnie Prince Charlie. Walk around the battlefield and the visitor center. Continue through majestic Highland scenery to a local farm for a demonstration of trained dogs herding sheep. Lunch. Visit of the Highland Folk museum . You will experience what life was like for folks here in the Highlands, from the 1700's through to the 20th century. The site covers a large area and you can explore the homes, farms, shops and schools of the past Travel through the high peaks of the Grampian Mountains Dinner at hotel.


