<p>Arrival at London Airport. Your guide and driver will wait for you after immigration controls. Transfert to your hotel. Early check in. Rest of morning at leisure. At 2,00pm your guide will meet you for guided panoramic tour of the city. Highlights include the Tower of London, Trafalgar square, Piccadilly circus, Westminster Abbey, St Paul's Cathedral, London bridge, Hyde park and many more .. In the evening, enjoy a welcome drink with your group before dinner at hotel.</p> <p>Overnight : London city centre.</p>	<p>English breakfast at hotel. This morning you will walk around Buckingham palace, the Official residence of The Queen. During this walk you will : meet the Squirrels and may be the pelicans in St James park, see Clarence house, the residence of Prince Charles and his wife Camilla, St James Palace, the official residence of the court. At Horse Guards parade, you will see part of the changing of the Queen's Life Guard. Depart to Windsor for lunch. Visit Windsor Castle, the oldest and largest occupied castle in the world and home to Kings and Queens for over a thousand years. See the magnificent State Apartments, and the St George's Chapel. Take photos of the walking guards.... Depart to Oxford. Dinner at hotel</p> <p>Overnight : Vicinity of Oxford.</p>	<p>English breakfast at hotel. Walking tour in the heart of Oxford; home of Oxford University and Christchurch College (founded by Henry VIII in the 16th century) which houses Christopher Wren's Tom Tower, the colleges most famous feature and an Oxford landmark. You may recognise the colleges grand staircase, cloisters and Oxford Bodleian Library as locations throughout Hogwarts in the Harry Potter movies. Depart to Blenheim Palace. Lunch en route. Visit the palace, the birthplace of the "greatest Briton of all time" Winston Churchill. Discover the 2,100 acres of beautiful parkland were landscaped by 'Capability Brown' who ensured the exquisite palace is surrounded by sweeping lawns, formal gardens and a magnificent lake. Then through the scenic Cotswold countryside, go to Stratford upon Avon Dinner at hotel.</p> <p>Overnight : Vicinity of Stratford upon Avon.</p>	<p>English breakfast at hotel. Shakespeare country, is this morning programme. You will explore the house where William Shakespeare was born in 1564 and raised. Captivating costumed guides will show you around the house he spent his childhood years and tell you tales of its colourful history. Discover the Holy Trinity Church where Shakespeare is said to be buried or the Guild Chapel and School Room where Shakespeare went to school. Lunch. En route to Cheltenham, a large spa town since the XVIII century. Stop for a cream tea in the regency town. After another short drive, arrive at Bristol Dinner at hotel.</p> <p>Overnight : Bristol.</p>

English breakfast at hotel.

Visit the wonderful city of Bath, reputed for its regency architecture; steeped in over a thousand years of history it has been a top destination for relaxation and pleasure since the Roman times. You will visit the Roman Baths; hot springs that were once believed to be the work of the Gods and attracted visitors from across the Roman Empire. Come face to face with costumed characters who will tell their stories and bring history to life. Lunch.

Travel to visit Stonehenge where you will follow in the footsteps of our Neolithic Ancestors. The first Stonehenge monument was built over 5000 years ago and it is unlikely anyone will ever know it's true purpose (an astronomical observatory, religious site, place of healing or a domain of the dead?) or even how the huge ancient stone structures were constructed using only primitive tools.

Travel to London. The rest of the day is free.

Overnight : London Central.

English breakfast at hotel.

This morning we head to the Tower of London to explore the fascinating history of the 950 year old fortress. The Tower has an infamous reputation for torture and turmoil, discover not only its gruesome past but also hear tales of luxury, banquets, daring escapes, jewels and it's past as a Royal Mint and menagerie of royal beasts. Discover the Crown Jewels, which include some of the most extraordinary diamonds in the world. Take photo of the Yeoman Wardens – who have resided in the Tower since being given the order from Henry VIII in the 16th century and offer free tours every 30 minutes. Look at the famous ravens, who, if according to legend, ever leave the tower both the Tower and England will fall. Lunch and afternoon at leisure.

Tonight you will sail on the river Thames. Step on board for an evening of sophistication, fine dining, and delightful entertainment. A smart way for a farewell dinner

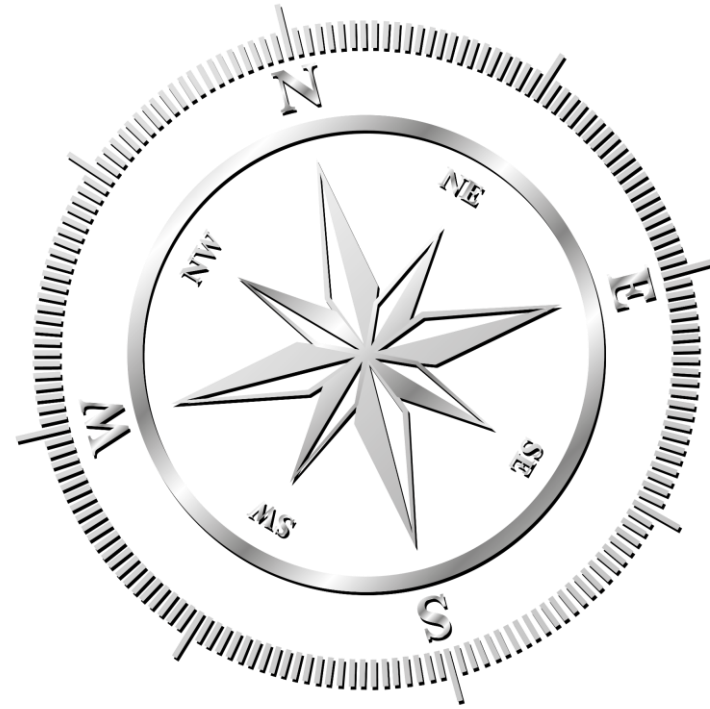
